The majestic Banqueting Hall is interchangeable as the ideal room for your civil ceremony with it's soaring vaulted ceiling, built in 1180.

The Elizabethan Library opens with an exposed fireplace, allowing for a spacious reception. The smell of beeswax, the revealing carpet and the breath-taking plasterwork ceiling.

The Games Room charm creates the perfect focal point for your day to begin.

Bailey Parlour and Tirrell's Lounge offers a place of quiet and relaxation for young and old alike.

The Queen Anne dining room, if walls could talk... the romantic poet William Wordsworth, writing three sonnets during his residence.

With three kitchens that offer space for your guests feeling like Brinsop is home from home. Supplying hampers in each, ready for the morning of your 2 day wedding to start the pre wedding preparations.

The Manor house serves you 18 unique bedrooms, providing sleeping arrangements for up to 33 of your guests.

# GLAMPING

## *Where's the Glamp site?*

The Glamping Tents are located in an ancient woodland area, behind The Knot barn and just a short stroll from the main Brinsop House. With 12 tents accommodating 24 guests, additional beds can be provided in the larger tents at an additional cost of £100.

## *What's included?*

All Brinsop Belle tents are equipped with; electric sockets, clothes rails, mirrors, coir matting, silk linings (for the colder and warmer weather), beds and mattresses, with 2 duvet covers for extra warmth.

A hairdryer, plug in heater, rugs, Egyptian cotton bedding, and a bedside table and lamp.

We also have dedicated facilities on-site, including toilets, showers and a kitchen.

Ivy Cottage sits just 200 metres away from the Manor House and the Knot barn. Ivy includes a private terrace, outdoor hot tub with far-reaching views over the estate and woodland.

Inside, you'll find a homely yet modern kitchen with a traditional cream Aga. Ivy's cosy sitting room has a warming wood burner with kindling and logs provided. Climb the stairs to the super king bed and beautiful bathroom, complete with walk-in shower, teardrop free-standing bath and plasma TV.

## WOOD

On the edge of the Brinsop Estate, the cosy Wood Cottage is tucked a little further away, making it the perfect escape!

Here, we've blended contemporary and rustic features, including an original wooden beamed ceiling, cosy wood burner, tear-drop bath and super king bed.

Set within an enclosed garden, enjoy views across Herefordshire hills from the private terrace which includes an outdoor hot tub. Wood cottage offers a gated driveway, perfect if you have a 4 legged friend!

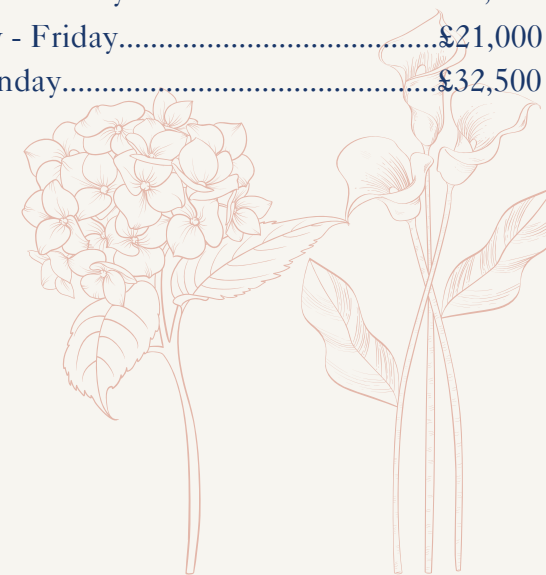

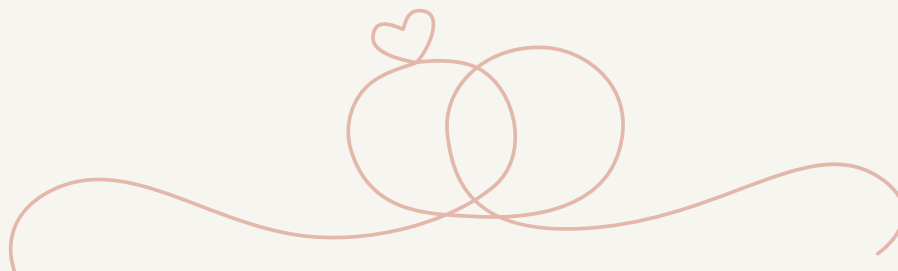

# THE HISTORY OF BRINSOP COURT ESTATE

## MEDIEVAL

The earliest lord of Brinsop recorded is Ralph Torrell/ Tirrell who was a benefactor in 1210. This was then later formally gifted to the family by Henry III, in thanks for their military aid. During the medieval century, we can see some of the key archaeological developments in the house. The beams in the Banqueting Hall are carbon-dated to 1180. The Banqueting Hall will have likely changed purpose numerous times- from an entertaining space to a granary! The Gothic room was suspected to be the court's chapel, with the below kitchen the crypt- which was recorded to have included a dungeon.

The Moat dates to the Tirrell family however was said to have had a drawbridge with two 'grotesque' monkeys standing guard.



## MODERN

The famous poet Wordsworth first visited Brinsop in 1827 to visit his sister who was living in the house with her family. He wrote numerous sonnets here including 'Lesbia' about a Miss Loveday Walker who lost her pet bird. Wordsworth's fellow poet Quillinan also wrote an 'epitaph to Prince', which was dedicated to Prince, the dog of his nephew. This epitaph can be seen in the banqueting hall under one of the windows.

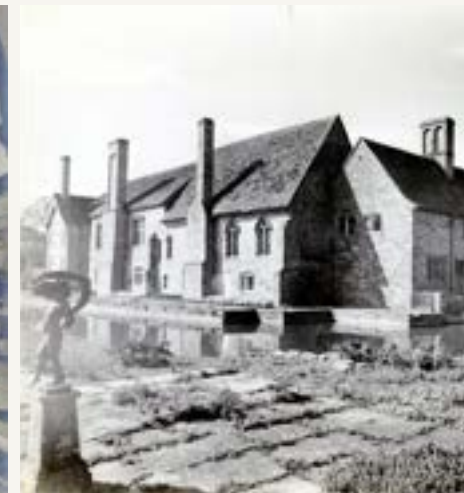
In the 1930s Captain Richard Astley lived in the house with his wife Madeline Carroll before their divorce in 1939. Madeline Carroll was a popular British Actress who in 1938 was the highest-paid actress in the world. She starred in films such as Alfred Hitchcock's '39 Steps' and 'What Money Can Buy'. Captain Astley did major work to the east wing during his time in Brinsop. Madeline also brought flamingos to the estate!

The most recent famous name in Brinsop History is Professor Stephen Hawking. Professor Hawking alongside his colleague Professor Andy Strominger would hold annual workshops for the scientific community, which they loved the lack of interruptions. They held the workshop the year he died to celebrate his amazing life.



## EARLY MODERN

During the Early modern period the house was owned by the Dansey family, who were of significant local importance- and were listed as the chief families in the local area. Throughout their ownership of Brinsop, they took part in many significant events. In 1642 Roger Dansey took the king's side in the English Civil War, something his family was later rewarded for with the return of the monarchy. In the late 1640s, William Dansey married Lady Douglas Dudley the granddaughter of the famous Robert Dudley, the favourite of Queen Elizabeth I. The Dansey family were suspected to marry Irish and Māori royalty after leaving Brinsop. The Dansey family also attributed key features to the house such as wooden cladding throughout the house and the Georgian moulding to the library.

# FAQs

## *CAN I BRING MY DOG?*

Absolutely! We welcome all (preferably well-behaved) dogs. They'll love lounging in front of the Aga. We can even provide a dog sitter should you request one for the duration of your stay.

## *DO WE HAVE TO BOOK THE REGISTRAR SEPARATELY?*

Yes, it is a legal requirement that you contact the Registrar separately, unfortunately we can't do this for you.

## *WHAT ARE THE CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT TIMES FOR GUESTS?*

A one-night wedding stays have access to French and Butterfly bedrooms from 11am on your wedding day.

Your house guests and day guests are then able to arrive from 1pm. Our bar can be open from 12 noon, on request in the games room, serving alcoholic and non alcoholic drinks. For two-night weddings, you have access to the entire Brinsop House and The Knot barn from 3pm the day before the wedding. Check out is at 11am.

## *DO YOU ALLOW CANDLES AND TEA LIGHTS?*

Yes, but please note that the banqueting hall and knot barn is the only locations where candles are permitted..

## *IS CONFETTI ALLOWED?*

Yes, although we ask that the confetti is either natural petals or bio-degradable. Sorry, no confetti canons.

## *WHAT TIME DO WE NEED TO FINISH OUR CELEBRATIONS AT NIGHT?*

Live music and/or DJ are both welcome to play in the The Knot or Games Room until midnight.

## *DO YOU ALLOW DRY HIRE?*

Unfortunately not. We have excellent bar facilities both at the Main House and The Knot and can work with you if you have any special requirements. We are unable to allow guests to bring any alcohol onsite.

## *DO YOU HAVE A CAKE STAND AND CAKE KNIFE?*

Yes, we have a log cake stand, which is 16- 17" in diameter, and a silver knife. Please remember to add this to your wedding information planning document and include information regarding the tiers you would like cut/saved.

## *HOW DO WE BOOK ACCOMMODATION?*

Please visit our accommodation portal. Our couples have their own unique booking code to distribute to the guests they choose to stay here at Brinsop.

## *WHEN IS GLAMPING AVAILABLE AT BRINSOP?*

Glamping is seasonal and available from Mid April through to October.

## *CAN I BRING MY OWN WEDDING DECORATIONS?*

Yes, of course you can. You are welcome to personalise and decorate the rooms to suit your event style. We have put hooks for decorations in appropriate places to help with the set-up process.

Please be aware that as a listed building, we cannot allow the use of tacks, nails, pins or blue tack to affix anything to the walls.

## *DO YOU TAKE CARD OR CASH?*

We are a cashless venue. Please make sure to let your guests know to bring card.

## *SHOULD WE PRE-BOOK TAXIS?*

As we are located in a rural area, we highly recommend pre-booking a taxi for the end of the night. There are plenty of companies in Hereford who will drop off and pick up from Brinsop Court Estate.

## *DO YOU HAVE ACCESSIBLE FACILITIES?*

Brinsop has a accessible ground floor super king bedroom, Hawkins, and wet room. bedrooms suitable for those with limited mobility – all on ground level. We can provide ramps for all stepped areas throughout the ground floor area meaning all 4 wings are accessible for most disabilities. Please note that our Library and Banqueting Hall are on the first floor. A lift is unavailable due to the building's historic age and listed status.

## *DO YOU ALLOW FIREWORKS?*

Yes, but we need to know ASAP to alert residents nearby. Please note that fireworks must be used by 10pm and sourced through our sole supplier.. Please see details on our suppliers list. We also allow sparklers outside.

## *HOW MANY GUESTS CAN WE HAVE?*

We can accommodate weddings here at Brinsop from 10 to 180 Day Guests! We can also accommodate up to 250 people for your evening party at The Knot with the addition of a marquee.

## *HOW MUCH ARE EXTRA BEDS AND SOFA BEDS?*

Our extra beds are £100 per bed, per person. This covers housekeeping linen change and breakfast on departure day.
